Christopher Alan Robinson of Loomis, California sadly passed away on August 6, 2023 at the age of 75.

Christopher, fondly known as Chris, was born on March 9, 1948 in Huntington, NY to Warren and Jean Robinson. He was the middle child of 5 boys over a 10 year span. He loved his brothers and family. Sports and school were the focus of the Robinson boys. Chris excelled at both. His intellect, curiosity, athleticism, and humor were very apparent and well recognized. He was incredibly intelligent.

Chris attended Clarkson University in New York and later transferred to The University of Michigan. He excelled in chemistry, math and engineering. During and after college he held several jobs including at a stock investment company on the New York Stock Exchange, engineering work on the foundation of the World Trade Center, Bendix Corporation and at a corporate chemistry lab. His boss at the NYSE favored the young Chris since he was the only one anyone had ever worked with who could memorize trade order numbers.

In 1972, he moved to San Francisco and started his 40+ year career founding his own construction company. He was soon building high end homes along the California coast and Bay Area. He was an exceptional builder. He loved

working with his hands on his own designs. He designed and built his own home in Moss Beach, CA where he lived until 2016. Every step of his work was methodically planned out, often just in his brain. He prided himself on the quality of his work. His relentless pursuit of perfection was evident in all his projects. In his spare time, Chris could often be seen with a book or computer in hand, pursuing his passions in science, astronomy and geography. He loved animals and especially dogs. Chris was an avid golfer.

When Chris was 33 he became a father to his only child, Laura Briana. He was an amazing father and he loved spending time with her. He was very engaged in her school, athletic and social activities. Laura and her husband Daniel Stoloski blessed Chris with 3 wonderful granddaughters, Gianna, Isabelle and Nina. It was evident to all around him that he was a proud and loving grandfather. In 2016 Chris moved to Loomis where he could be close to his family. They were the pride and joy of his life.

Chris was always smiling. He had a unique spirit and he definitely left an impression on anyone he came in contact with. He was a great father, a devoted grandfather, a loving brother and an all around wonderful person. He will be deeply missed by his friends, family, and all who knew him.
