Gladys Frances Thompson, 98, passed away peacefully in her sleep on May 13th, 2026, in Rocklin, CA. Gladys was born on May 16th, 1927, to Francis Xavier O'Rourke Reed and Mary Gladys Kennedy. She was a cherished mother of 5, grandmother of 10, great-grandmother of 16, great-great-grandmother of 2, and her presence will be deeply missed.

An avid world traveler with an appreciation for other cultures, Gladys and Garrie traveled to many countries during their retirement. They also traveled in a motorhome to many U.S. states, taking their grandchildren with them on many adventures. Gladys enjoyed reading, knitting, crafts, tap dancing, and watching cowboy movies every Saturday.

Gladys is survived by her daughter and son, Carol (Al) and David (Donya); daughters-in-law, Diane and Penny; 10 grandchildren, Garrie, Michael, Amanda, Maris, James, Ryan, Rachelle, Cassandra, Chad, and Chelsea; 16 great-grandchildren; and 2 great-great-grandchildren. Gladys was preceded in death by her husband, Garrie, and 3 sons, Ricky, Wayne, and Bruce. She was also preceded in death by her sister, Barbara Reed, and her brother, Mark Reed, who she was close with before their passing.
