Lawrence Allen "Larry" Freeman, 76, of Rocklin, Ca, passed away at his home on February 20, 2024 after a long battle with Parkinson's Disease. Born on May 30, 1947, in Santiago, Chile, Larry was a beloved husband, father, grandfather, brother, and friend.
