Oscar Molina Miguelino, Sr. passed away unexpectedly at home on February 18, 2026, with his beloved wife by his side. Born in Naic, Cavite, Philippines, Oscar lived a life defined by quiet brilliance, steady strength, and deep faith.

A graduate of the Philippine College of Arts and Trade, he spent more than 35 years as an electrical engineer at NGC (formerly ESL/TRW), contributing to groundbreaking defense technologies including early UAVs, advanced tanks, and stealth aircraft. He survived the 1988 ESL mass shooting and returned to his work with the same calm determination that shaped his life.

Oscar's greatest transformation came through his faith. At St. Joseph Catholic Church, he found his voice — singing, playing guitar, and sharing a warmth that touched family, friends, and his church community.

He was a devoted husband to Florentina for 54 years, a loving father to Oscar Jr. & Judy and Florylynn & Bryon, and a proud grandfather to Maxwell, Alexis, Brooklynn, Eva, and Ayla. He is also survived by his siblings Oliver and Myrna, and by many nieces and nephews who cherished him.

Inventive, generous, and steadfast, Oscar could fix anything, build anything, and uplift anyone. His legacy lives on in the lives he shaped, the faith he shared, and the love he gave so quietly and so well.

He will be deeply missed and forever remembered.
