Robert Claude Adair was born on May 16, 1948, in Stockton, California to Claude and Laretta Adair and was born again on December 19, 1957, when he received the Holy Ghost at the age of nine. He grew up in Stockton and began his journey into ministry as the youth leader at Christian Life Center, under the leadership of Rev. Clyde Haney.
