JORGENSEN, Terrence "Terry" Dean (71) passed away on July 6, 2024, in his home in Roseville, CA surrounded by his family. Terry, known to many as TJ was born on September 21, 1952, in Yankton, SD to Wayne M Jorgensen & Roberta M Jorgensen (Asbra). The family home was in Cedar County, NE.

Terry's family moved to Orland, CA when he was 2 years old. He was a 1970 graduate of Orland High School. Terry went on to earn his AA in Liberal Arts from Butte College and his BA in Resource Management with a minor in Law Enforcement from Sacramento State
